SENIOR MAX REPORT

STEVENS ON THE TOP STEP OF THE PODIUM



Vic Stevens (Bouvin Power) was surprisingly victorious. The Belgian was immediately among the fastest drivers, with the time of 54.115 seconds in Group 3 in the qualifying practices, behind only Macauley Bishop (Dan Holland Racing) in the combined rankings. In the following qualifying heats, Stevens achieved two seconds, two thirds and a fourth place, but nevertheless slipped from second to sixth at the end of the day on Saturday. After the third position of prefinal B, Stevens was ready to assert himself in the final, excited from the start: in fact, on the second lap, the race was neutralized with a "slow" regime due to an accident at the back, while on the seventh lap Kai Hunter

(Hunter Motorsport) withdrew after a contact with Cian Geraghty (Strawberry Racing), just as the two were fighting for the top positions. A couple of laps later, race leader Mark Kimber (Strawberry Racing) made contact with Matthew Higgins (Dan Holland Racing) and the latter spun out. On the last lap, Bishop and Stevens overtook Kimber and were first and second under the chequered flag. However, a five-second penalty for front fairing not in the correct position relegated Bishop to 15th place and victory went to Stevens, followed on the podium by Austin Lee (Kraft Motorsport) and Ethan Jeff-Hall (Sam Pollitt Racing), who were able to recover 9 and 12 positions respectively from the start.

JUNIOR MAX REPORT

ASHCROFT'S UNDISPUTED DOMINATION



Nobody was able to trouble Jacob Ashcroft (Dan Holland Racing) over the course of the weekend. The Brit took pole position, thanks to the best time of 55.237 seconds achieved in group 1, and also achieved two victories in the following qualifying heats. Only in the third and final race did the Englishman finish second, behind Toms Strele (Dan Holland Racing). However, Ashcroft reconfirmed himself at the top of the intermediate standings at the end of Saturday, thus securing first place on the starting grid of the final after his success in prefinal A. At the start of the last race of the weekend, the Dan Holland Racing driver retained the lead and,

after just two laps, was almost two seconds ahead of his closest pursuers. In the second part of the race, Ties Van Wijk (Bouvin Power) tried to close the gap on Ashcroft but the latter crossed the finish line first with a 3.866-second advantage over the Belgian. Strele and Cameron Nelson (Dan Holland Racing), in contention for the podium, made contact with two laps to go and withdrew. Boaz Maximov (Bouvin Power) took advantage of this, finishing third ahead of Noah Janssen (Doerr Motorsport), Adrians Tions (MRG Racing) and Conor Clancy (Strawberry Racing).

BELGIAN CUP BY MINI MAX REPORT

BÁBÍČEK IS KING AGAIN IN BELGIUM



After the podium at the Winter Cup in Campillos, Zdeněk Bábíček (Tepz Racing Team) won the Belgian Cup by Mini MAX. The Czech finished third in Friday's qualifying practices, behind AJ Burggraaff (SP Motorsport) and Harry Taylor (Dan Holland Racing), while during the qualifying heats he achieved three wins and climbed to the top of the intermediate standings. Bábíček also triumphed in Prefinal A and secured pole position for the final, ahead of Albert Friend (Strawberry Racing), Burggraaff and Michal Zajac (Dan Holland Racing). In the last race of the weekend, Bábíček defended his lead on the first

bends, but on the third lap it was Friend who took the lead. The Tepz Racing Team driver responded to the Briton's attack by overtaking him on the next lap and regained the lead, after which a surprise happened: Friend and Jenson Chalk (Strawberry Racing) made contact and withdrew. Bábíček defended himself very well in the second part of the race and won, followed by Vince Vanderhallen (Bouvin Power) in second place and Oliver Warner (Dan Holland Racing) in third. Ninth place for Zajac and 14th for Taylor, while Burggraaff did not finish the final.

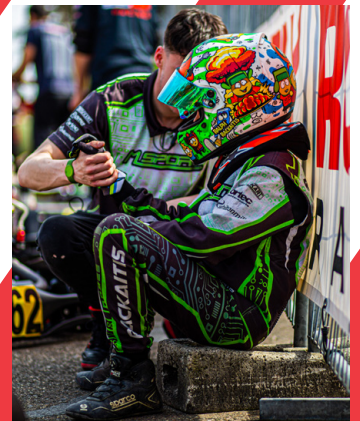

BOL GETS EVERYTHING RIGHT



Solo victory for Enzo Bol (SP Motorsport) in the first round of the championship. The Dutchman took a third place in Friday's qualifying practices, finishing behind polesitter Paul Fourquemin (Daems Racing Team) and David Aulejtner (Schepers Racing Service), while in the following qualifying heats he achieved two wins and a second place, enough to climb to the top of the intermediate standings. Bol finished second in prefinal A on Sunday morning, but kept first position in the final standings, a result that allowed him to start ahead of everyone in the

final. The SP Motorsport driver made no mistakes at the start and immediately began to gain an advantage over his pursuers, bringing the gap to two seconds after just six laps. After administering the second half of the race, Bol passed under the chequered flag first, while Patriks Noels Locmelis (MRG Racing) took second place. Bende Szabo (Szabo Bende) beat Tomass Birstins (MRG Racing) to secure the lowest step of the podium. Through an eight-place comeback, Xen De Ruwe (AKK Sportstil) finished fifth at the finish line.

PICOT'S MASTERFUL PERFORMANCE



A weekend to remember for Nicolas Picot (Picot Nicolas) in Genk. The Frenchman led everyone in the qualifying practices, achieving pole position with a time of 54.059 seconds. He then twice won in the qualifying heats, a second place behind his rival Harlads Garkaklis (Garkaklis Harlads) and won the prefinal. Thanks to this series of results, Picot secured first position on the starting grid of the final, ahead of Garkaklis, Igor Mukhin (Mukhin Igor) and Christophe Adams (Adams Christophe). When the lights went out in the last race, Picot had a

lightning-fast sprint and immediately overwhelmed his rivals, increasing his advantage minute by minute. At the end of the scheduled 15 laps, Picot triumphantly crossed the finish line, beating the competition of Garkaklis, who came second, and Mukhin, who came third. Martynas Tankevicius (Lenktynių Linija) finished at the foot of the podium, followed by Adams in fifth place, Christophe Capitaine (RM Concept) in sixth place and Bastian Krapoth (Kartschmie.de) in seventh place.
